

Graves into Gardens lyrics

Graves into Gardens became the first No. 1 single on the US Hot Christian Songs chart for Elevation Worship and Brandon Lake. The song also reached her No. 2 on the Bubbling Under Hot 100 chart, becoming the highest charting single for both acts. The song won the 2021 Billboard Music Awards for Best Christian Song for Her. "Graves into Gardens" won the GMA Dove Award for Worship Recorded Song of the Year and at the 2021 GMA the Spanish version of Song of the Year and the song "Tumbas A Jardines" won Song of the Year in Spanish. Nominated. Pigeon Award.
